**Please use Chrome or Firefox as your browser throughout the Summit, and access the site using a desktop or laptop computer. The site is NOT functional on smartphones or tablets.** And if you have trouble with any of the platform's functions, our team is always here to help! (More on that below.)

**We highly encourage you to explore the site before the Summit begins.** Now that you have your login information, you can access the site at any time! Make sure to save your password.

## NAVIGATING THE SITE

When you first log in to the Lab Directors Virtual Summit, you will see a navigation menu on the left with links to every section of the site. Below are brief descriptions of what some important sections do.



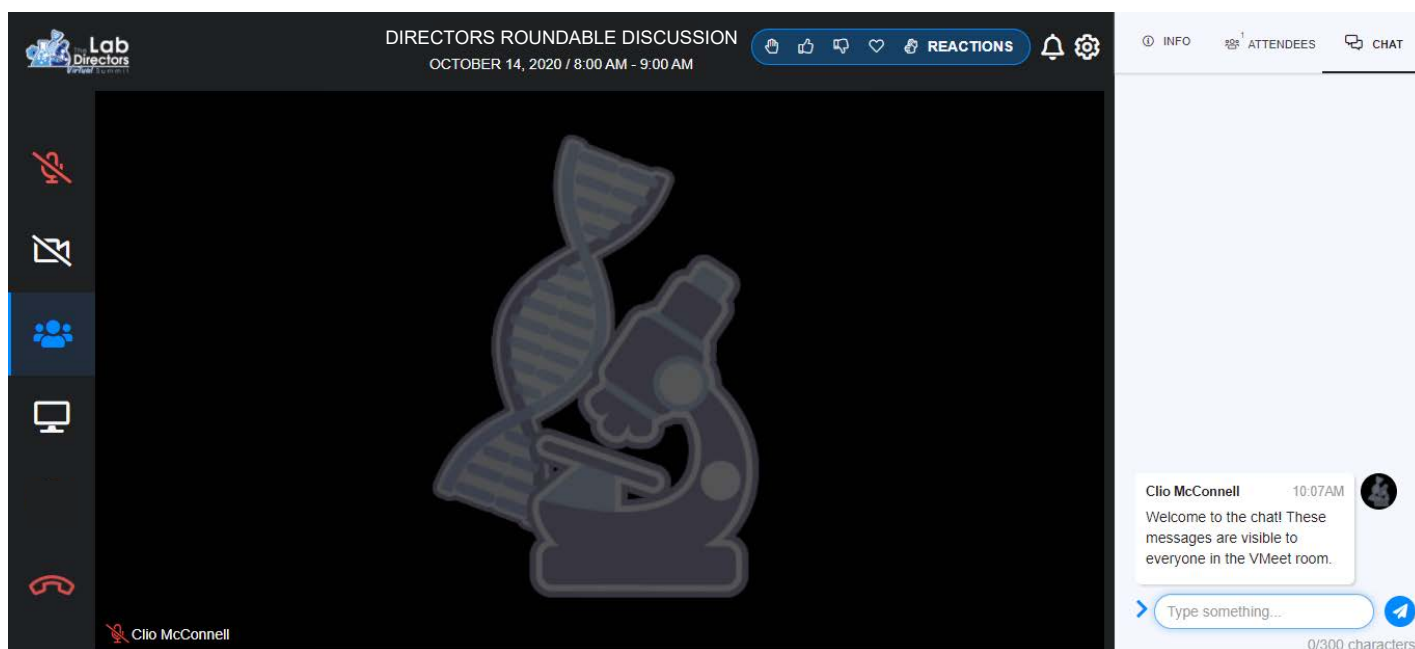
- **My Agenda:** This is where your personalized agenda lives for all three days of the Summit, and you can reference it at any time. Toggle between days at the top and scroll down to see your full schedule of daily meetings. To join a meeting, click the “Join VMeet” button – more details on that in the section below.
- **Directories:** In Directors and the Supplier Rep Directory, you will find details about Summit participants, which you can refer to at any time – it's especially useful to keep this tab open during your one-to-one meetings! Visit any individual's profile to see the option to Schedule a Meeting with them outside of Summit hours.
- **FAQ/Help Desk:** Visit this page if you need help. For questions about the event, use the link to the Help Desk, where you can chat in real-time with Summit staff. ## PARTICIPATING IN MEETINGS

In your Agenda, each meeting has a “Join VMeet” button. Clicking this brings you to a meeting room in a new browser tab with video and audio. **If at any point you lose video or audio, refresh the page or close the tab and re-enter the room from your agenda.** If that doesn't fix the issue, email [labdirectorssummit2020@gramercytech.zendesk.com](mailto:labdirectorssummit2020@gramercytech.zendesk.com) to message tech support.

In all meeting rooms *except full group sessions*, you'll see a menu of icons on the left: microphone, camera, room info/chat, share screen, and hang up.



- The  icon will bring up a sidebar with three tabs: **info and materials, a list of other attendees in the meeting room, and a live chat**
  - Note: any message you send in the VMeet room chat will be visible to the whole group – use it for questions and comments!
- You will see additional **ACTIONS** icons at the top right of your screen, including an option to **raise your hand** 
  - In a full group session, if you have a question or comment that you'd like to contribute aloud, click the hand icon. This will indicate to the speaker that they should call on you!
